### CONDITIONS

Rules and Regulations are governed by Ohio State Racing Commission, U.S.T.A., and O.C.R.A. Declarations for all events close at 10:00 A.M. 2 days before the race. All phoned entries must have information as to U.S.T.A. Rules. 3% entrance fee in overnight events except the Fayette County Classic. Track will score 6 wide.

Right reserved to reject any entry, to declare off or rearrange program as conditions may require. The U.S.T.A. Rules are to be used with right to use Rule No. 13, Sec. 2 (A), if necessary.

In case of a split in any overnight event, we reserve the right to race in divisions or eliminations. We reserve the right to require six separate interests in each overnight event. Purse divided: 50 - 25 - 12 - 8 - 5 percent. Horses are brought on grounds at owner's risk. Fayette Co. Fair assumes no liability for accidents.
